For the daytime event 10-16, admission is free for under 16s, £3 for Adults.

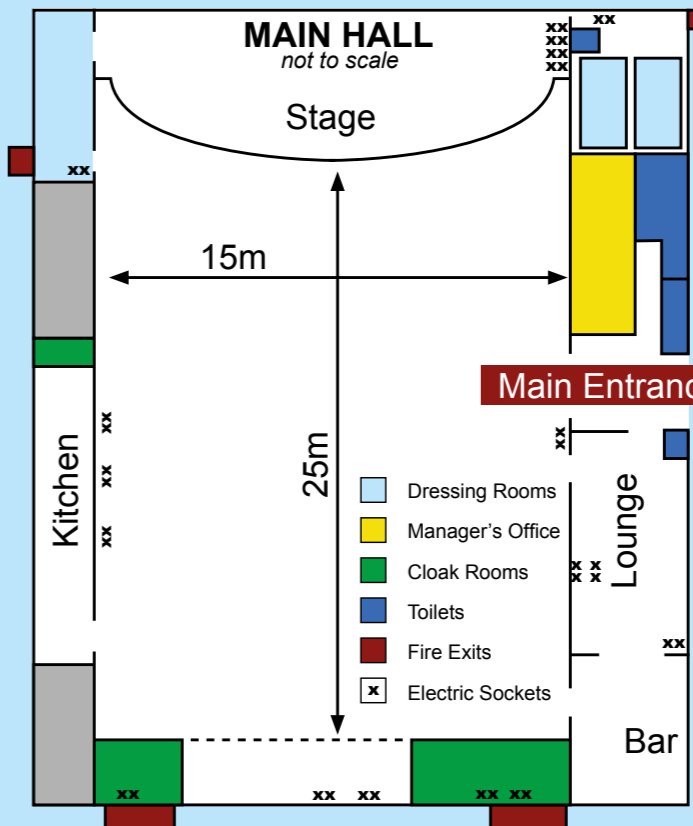
Evening afterparty is separate at £5 from 19-23:00 over 18s only.

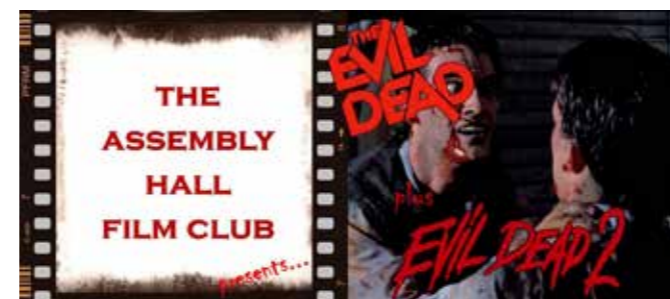

Bored of life in the garden, Peter goes to the big city, where he meets shady characters and ends up creating chaos for the whole family.

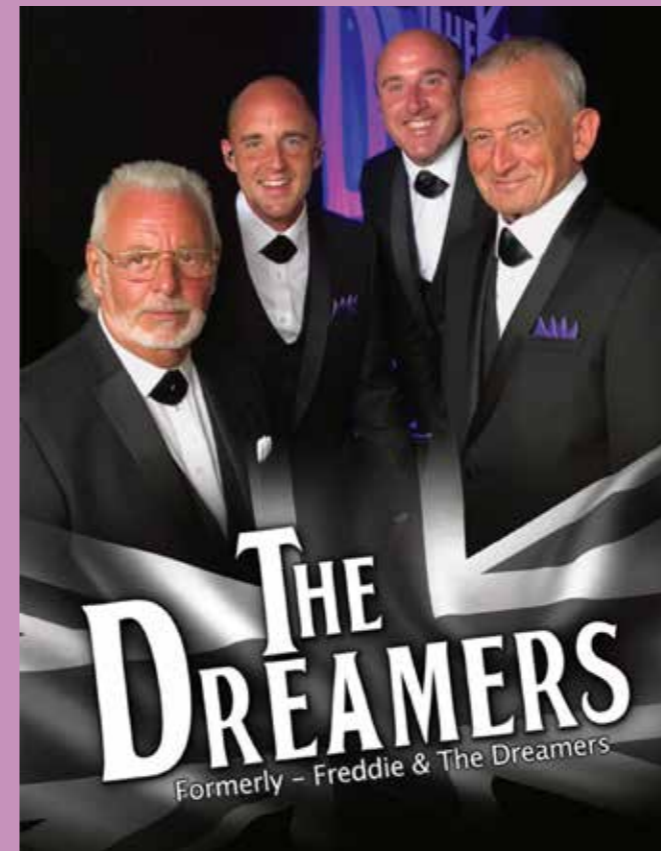


EVIL DEAD & EVIL DEAD 2
